Edward J. "Red" Heuer, Sr., 87, of Hebron, died Tuesday, June 15, 2010 at his residence.

Edward was born in Chicago, IL on January 5, 1923, the son of the late Clarence and Kathryn (McGuire) Heuer.

He graduated from Leyden High School in 1941.

He was married to Betty F. Pierce on June 27, 1944 in Traverse City, Michigan.

He owned and operated Heuer's Restaurant, first in Rosemont, then Richmond for over 40 years retiring in 1985.

He attended St. Joseph Catholic Church in Richmond.

He served in the U.S. Navy from December 1942 to December 1945 as a Machinists Mate in WW II, serving aboard the USS Auburn. He was a member of Paul C. Hoffman American Legion Post # 253.
