Dr. Eugene "Doc" V. Hoffmann, Jr., 72, of Richmond, IL, passed away Wednesday, April 17, 2013 at Aurora Memorial Hospital, Burlington, WI.

"Doc" was born in Chicago, on May 17, 1940, a son of the late Dr. Eugene and Elizabeth (Cholack) Hoffmann, Sr.

He was a graduate of Fenwick High School, graduated from National College of Chiropractic in 1962 and was assistant director at the teaching clinic.
