



Frances "Boots" Gritmacker

October 10, 1924 - January 12, 2013

Frances "Boots" Gritmacker, formerly of Hebron, died Saturday January 12, 2013.

She was born October 10, 1924 in Crystal Lake to Frank and Ella (Jesse) Pinnow. On May 29, 1943, she married Arthur Gritmacker in Woodstock and he died June 3, 2001.

Boots was a homemaker and she helped her husband run a dairy farm for more than 30 years. Her hobbies included growing flowers, baking, piecing quilts and crocheting. She was a member of St. John's Lutheran Church in Hebron and a former member of the Alden-Hebron Grange and McHenry County Farm Bureau.
