Frederick S. Carroll, 67, of Richmond, IL, passed away Saturday, December 6, 2014 at Centegra Hospital, McHenry, IL.

He was born in Baltimore, MD on January 3, 1947, a son of the late Miles and Mary Louise (Steil) Carroll.

He was a graduate of St. Paul's School in Baltimore in 1965, earned a Bachelors from American University in Washington, DC, and a Masters from American Graduate School of International Management in AZ.

He was married to Nancy Neucks on Oct. 18, 1982 in Evansville, IN.

After working as a salesman for Stryker Equipment, he and Nancy formed Merit Medical in McHenry, which they operated for 20 years.

Fred was a member and past president of Richmond-Spring Grove Rotary Club. He enjoyed antique cars and had a keen interest in books, especially about history. He also served as Republican precinct captain for several years.

He served in the U.S. Army as a SP 4 during the Vietnam War, earning the Combat Infantry Badge and was awarded multiple Purple Heats.
