Fred L. Young, age 85 of Sturtevant, WI, formerly of Richmond, passed away Wednesday July 25, 2012 while in the company of family members at Wheaton Franciscan Health Center in Racine, WI.

Fred was born in St. Paul, NE on January 26, 1927, a son of the late Henry and Lillian (Huntworth) Young.

He was married to Gloria J. Fay on June 17, 1949 in Elgin, IL and she died Jan. 3, 1984. He then married Shirley Messemore in 1991 and she died 1996.

He was a self employed poultry/agricultural farmer in the Richmond area for over 20 years. Following retirement, he worked as a custodian at Hearthstone Village in Woodstock for 8 years.

He served in the U.S. Navy as a Seaman 1st Class in WW II, aboard the USS Oakland. He was a former member of VFW in Lake Villa.

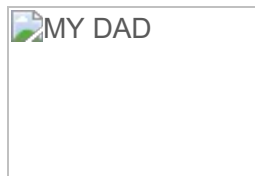
He never let me down, and was the best. I can't think of my life without him being part of it, but I know he has been holding me up and will continue to support, care and will always love me.

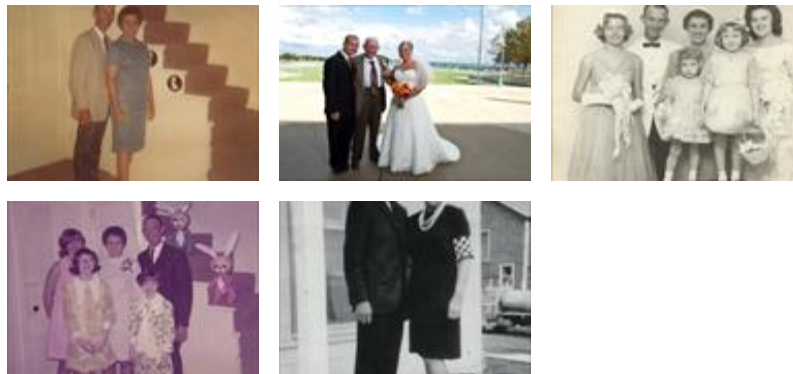
