George T. Hellmann, 82, of Richmond, IL, passed away Tuesday, January 2, 2018 at his residence.

He was born in Covington, KY on December 31, 1935, a son of the late Wilfrid and Dorothy (Herrmann) Hellmann.

He was married to Kathleen Steinwand on June 6, 1964, at Colby, WI.
