James P. Nor, 76, of Richmond, IL, passed away Friday, May 27, 2022 at Advocate Condell Medical Center, Libertyville, IL.

He was born in Woodstock, Illinois on August 21, 1945, a son of the late Jens K. and Helen (Robers) Nor.

He was married to Lily Converse on Oct. 29, 1966, in Richmond, IL.

He was a graduate of Alden-Hebron High School in 1963.

Jim joined the U.S. Marines in Dec. 1964, was wounded in action March 1966 in Vietnam, receiving the Purple Heart and the Bronze Star and discharged in Aug. 1966. He was a member of Paul C. Hoffman American Legion Post #253 and the Marine Corps League.

He was a self-employed farmer in Richmond, for over 40 years, retiring 2010.

He was a member of Grace Lutheran Church in Richmond.

He was a Football coach for Youth Leagues and Junior Tackle and High School umpire for Baseball, Softball and Football.

Jim is survived by his wife Lily, a daughter Linda Nor, of Genoa City, WI; two sons David (Dot) Nor, of Richmond, Douglas (Kattie) Nor, of Twin Lakes, WI; five grandchildren, Helena Nor, Hannah Nor, Ashlynn Nor, Riley Nor and Dylan Nor and a brother Art (Marilyn) Nor, of Florida. He was preceded by parents.

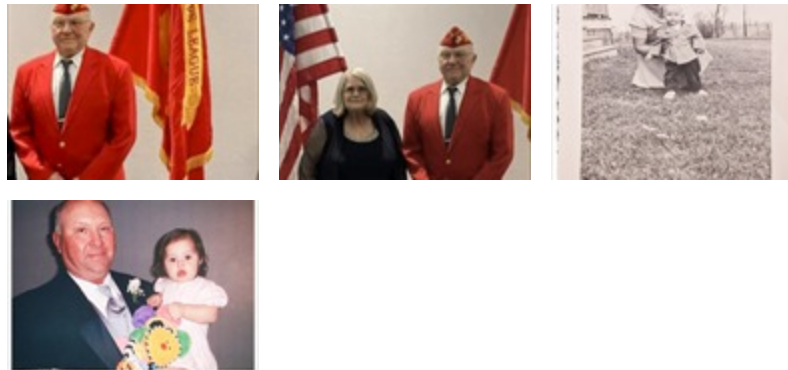
