Jeffrey M. "Jeff" Helland, 56, of Hebron, IL, passed away suddenly Saturday, September 12, 2015 at Advocate Lutheran General Hospital, Park Ridge, IL.

Jeffrey was born in Superior, WI on February 18, 1959, a son of the late Maurice and Thelma (Doege) Helland.

He was a graduate of Cary-Grove High School in 1976.

He owned and operated Eagle Automotive in Round Lake Beach, IL., for 5 years, retiring June of this year. Prior to that he served as inventory manager of Tru-Serv Mfg in Cary for over 30 years.
