Leslie P. Meusling, 97, of Hebron, IL, passed away Thursday, August 1, 2013 while in the company of his loving children.

Leslie was born in Hartland Township on November 13, 1915, the youngest son of the late Christ and Marie (Roeder) Meusling.

He was a graduate of Genoa City High School in 1933.
