Luz Maria “Lucy” Sepulveda was born February 19, 1947, in Yabucoa, Puerto Rico, to Juan Rodriguez Sepulveda and Rosa Davila Sepulveda, and passed away peacefully at home in McHenry, Illinois, on August 25, 2025, surrounded by family. She was 78.

As a teenager, she and her family moved to Chicago, Illinois, where she would grow up, put down roots, and blossom into the vibrant woman so many knew and loved. In her youth, Lucy was crowned Miss Puerto Rico runner-up at a Puerto Rican festival in Humboldt Park—an early glimpse of her radiant beauty and lively spirit.
