Norbert P. Selking, 77, of McHenry, formerly Hebron, passed away Friday, August 16, 2013, at Heritage Woods in McHenry.

Norbert was born in Decatur, Indiana on November 15, 1935, a son of the late August and Frieda (Gallmeyer) Selking.

He was a graduate of Monmouth High School in Indiana and attended Valpariso University and received the Jaycee distinguished service award in Decatur.

He was a hog farmer from 1953 to 1981, retiring in 1981.

He was a member of Fox Lake Community Church in Fox Lake, IL.

He was a member of the Community Advisory Council of Hebron Schools for 3 years, Community Upholding Persons (CUP) which is a jail ministry, for 40 years.

He served in the U.S. Army as a Spec 4/C, from 1957 to 1960.

Norbert is survived by two daughters, Rachel (Mary Noonan) Selking, of Lake Geneva, WI; Hannah Itzin, of Nashville, TN; three sons Andrew (Paige) Selking, of Ft. Huachuca, AZ; John (Yen) Selking, of Roundhock, TX; Joel (Karen) Selking, of Chicago, IL; eight grandchildren: two sisters, Ruth Ann Schimmel, of Ft. Wayne, IN; Janeen (Willard) Merkle, of Van Wert, Ohio. He was preceded by a grandson Aaron Selking, a sister Margaret Freudenburg and a brother Richard Selking
