Raymond D. Davis, age 93, of Salem, WI, formerly of Chicago and Evanston, IL, passed away Friday, November 24, 2023 while in the company of family members, at Archwood Senior Living in Salem, WI.

He was born in Chicago, IL on May 11, 1930, a son of the late Flora (Waggoner) and Custer C. Davis.

He was a graduate of Glenbard High School in 1948.

Ray was married to Esther Blaum on May 30, 1954, at St. John's Church in Chicago and she died Nov. 9, 2004. He married Ruth Ann Smith in Oct. 1996 and she died Apr. 2011.

He served in the U.S. Army Engineers and the Airborne from 1951 to 1954 with time in Korea, where he received two Overseas Bars, three Bronze Service Stars and United Nations Service Medal.

Ray loved fishing, playing the harmonica, writing short stories, was an avid reader and loved spending time with his family.

He was a police officer for the City of Evanston, IL from 1958-1980. He was a member of the Wheaton Masonic Lodge.
