



## Richard "Rich" Jacobson

March 11, 1935 - March 23, 2023

Richard L. Jacobson, 88, of Fox Lake, IL, formerly of Richmond passed away Thursday, March 23, 2023 at St. Catherine's Hospital in Pleasant Prairie, WI.

He was born in Genoa City, WI on March 11, 1935, the son of the late Evelyn (Ehle) and Roy Jacobson.

He was married to Arlene Kelly on July 11, 1992, in Richmond.

Rich was preceded in death by his first wife Jeanette (Huff) Jacobson on September 27, 1990 and their daughter Melissa Ann Jacobson on May 18, 2009.

Rich graduated from Richmond-Burton High School in 1953. He served in the U.S. Army during 1957-58 then returned home to run the family farm.

He was a lifetime farmer and a member of the McHenry County Farm Bureau.

Rich was a volunteer fireman and a trustee for the Richmond Fire Department for 39 years. A proud member of 4H, the local snowmobile club, and an avid card player. He delighted in serving his community and loved hosting events that brought people together such as Easter egg hunts, hayrides, and pig roasts. He was always up for an adventure, and would drop everything to help anyone at any time. Given the opportunity, he would talk to everybody. He never met a stranger, just someone he was not friends with yet. Above all else, farming was what he lived for. It was his calling. Rich was a mentor to many, a friend to all.

Survivors are his wife Arlene, step children Susan (the late Frankie) Cherry, Tim (Lisa) Kelly, Tony (Silvia) Kelly; six grandchildren, ten great grandchildren, a sister Carolyn (the late Verne ) Borst, and many nieces and nephews.

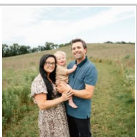
