Shirley A. Lang, 84, of Lac Du Flambeau, WI, passed away peacefully Monday, November 28, 2022 at Aurora Memorial Hospital, Burlington, WI after a short illness.

She was born in Racine, WI on March 16, 1938, a daughter of the late John and Florence (Dresen) Stindle.

She graduated from Horlick High School in Racine and worked at Johnson Wax. She married Martin P. Lang on July 14, 1962. They eloped and honeymooned for a month traveling the western states. They moved to California for several years where they started their family. After returning to Kenosha, she stayed at home for several years raising her three children. She worked at Ocean Spray and then went back to Johnson Wax where she retired in 1991 as a forklift driver.
